4. Participating Organisations

This competition is open to all authorised martial arts organisations, institutions and individual practitioners, including but not limited to cultural centres (halls and schools), kindergartens, social organisations, martial arts institutions and clubs.

All participants must register through the Organising Committee's designated liaison officer and complete the online registration process. Participation is subject to review and approval by the **Organizing Committee of the Singapore New Kungfu Games**, and competitors may participate only after receiving official confirmation.

5. Registration / Competition Schedule

Registration Period: 1 June 2026 – 1 October 2026 (Singapore Time)

Kungfu Games Date: 18 October 2026 (Local Time)

Results Announcement: 18 October 2026 (Local Time)

Participation Requirement: Group registration only (or recommendation by the participant's instructor). Individual registrations will not be accepted.

6. Competition Format

The **2026 Singapore New Kungfu Games** will be conducted through on-site evaluation by the judging panel. New Kungfu Games Ambassadors will provide one-on-one guidance to participants on-site. Every participant will receive one complimentary gift package.

8. Participation Guidelines

Participants

Martial arts associations, organisations, academies, and schools from all countries and regions may participate as teams, or competitors may participate upon recommendation by their instructor or coach.

Event Registration

Each participant may register for multiple events. There is no limit on the number of boxing, weapon or group events entered. However, participants should avoid registering for events that may result in scheduling conflicts. Participants must clearly list all registered events on the printed registration form.

9. Competition Rules

1. Traditional boxing and traditional weapon events shall be conducted in accordance with the **1998 Wushu Competition Rules**. Competition Changquan routines and Competition Taijiquan events shall be conducted in accordance with the **2024 Wushu Competition Rules**.

2. To ensure fairness and transparency, all competitions will be live-streamed. Details of the live-streaming channels and schedule will be announced through the Organising Committee's official platform.

3. Competition duration shall follow the **2024 Wushu Competition Rules**. Traditional routines are recommended to be completed within **1 minute**. Taijiquan events shall conclude within **4 minutes**, with an audible signal at **3 minutes**.

4. Competition attire: Competitors may wear either traditional martial arts uniforms or competition uniforms. Weapons shall be prepared by the participants.

5. To facilitate customs clearance, the Organising Committee will provide standard weapons in standard sizes, including broadswords, spears, staffs, swords, double hooks, daggers, nunchaku, and other basic weapons. Participants may choose to bring their own weapons. Specialised weapons must be provided by the participants themselves, and customs clearance must be arranged in advance. The Organising Committee will provide assistance where required.

10. Awards and Recognition

Individual Awards

First Place: **Certificate and Gold Excellence Medal**

Second Place: **Certificate and Silver Excellence Medal**

Third Place: **Certificate and Bronze Excellence Medal**

Each event will have only one Gold Excellence Award. No tied awards will be presented.

First Prize: **Certificate and Gold Medal**

Second Prize: **Certificate and Silver Medal**

Third Prize: **Certificate and Bronze Medal**

Encouragement Award: **Certificate**

Flying Dragon Health Qigong Championship

Participants who successfully complete the full Flying Dragon Health Qigong routine will receive a specially designed **award certificate, medal, and prize** from the Organising Committee.

The Champion in each age category will receive an additional SGD 100 cash award.

The overall Flying Dragon Health Qigong Championship winners will receive the following cash awards:

- Champion: **SGD 500**
- First Runner-up: **SGD 300**
- Second Runner-up: **SGD 200**

The oldest participant or the youngest participant in the Flying Dragon Health Qigong Championship will receive a SGD 500 cash award.

11. Fees and Regulations

Registration for Singapore Local Teams:

Registration must be submitted as a team. The registration fee is **SGD 60 per participant**, with **no limit on the number of events**. **No additional administrative fees** will be charged.

Registration for Overseas Teams:

The registration fee is **RMB 300 per participant**. No additional administrative fees will be charged.

Health Declaration:

Each **participating team is responsible for verifying the age and health condition of its athletes**. Please tick the checkbox if there is no objection.

Liability Declaration:

Each **All team members must agree to the Safety and Liability Declaration** in order to complete their registration. (Please tick the checkbox during registration.)

Visa Arrangements for Overseas Participants:

The organiser may assist registered participants with visa applications (visa exemption applies to certain countries), or participants may arrange their own entry procedures.

Administrative fee: SGD 50.

Package for Overseas Teams:

The package fee is **RMB 8,800 per person**, which includes:

- One-day Singapore Highlights Tour
- Participation in **up to three competition events**
- **4 days and 3 nights** accommodation in a **3-star standard hotel**
- Airport coach transfers

- Tour guide services
- Three meals per day
- Official Celebration Banquet

Additional competition events beyond the first three will be charged at SGD 60 or RMB300 per event.

Additional event fee:

RMB 60 per event (applicable when registering for more than three events).

Customised Package for Overseas Teams:

Overseas participants may customise their itinerary. Fees will be adjusted according to the selected package at the organiser's discretion.

15. Responsibilities of Participating Organisations and Individuals

Participating organisations and individuals must comply with the laws and regulations of their respective countries or regions and ensure that all conduct during the event meets the highest standards.

Basic Principles

Any individual who violates the rules, principles, interests, or objectives of this New Kungfu Competition may have their participation suspended or their competition eligibility revoked.

Sportsmanship

Participants shall compete in the spirit of martial arts and demonstrate proper etiquette and conduct. While participating, they also represent their respective countries, cities, or organisations. Each participating organisation is responsible for ensuring that its team members uphold good sportsmanship and proper discipline throughout the event.

Participant Image Rights

Each participating organisation authorises the **International Intangible Cultural Heritage Kungfu Promotion Centre** to use the image, photographs, and videos of all participants. The Organising Committee may use such materials for publicity and promotional purposes in any form as it deems appropriate.

Insurance

Each participating organisation is fully responsible for arranging **personal accident insurance** and **third-party liability (public liability) insurance** for its participants throughout the competition.

Health Protection

Participants should maintain good physical health, undergo regular martial arts training, and register only for events appropriate to their physical condition. If a participant feels unwell during the competition, they should stop immediately and seek medical attention.

16. Miscellaneous

Competition Attire

All participants competing in **New Kungfu Games Competition** events must wear uniforms that comply with the competition dress code. *(All participants are required to prepare their own competition uniforms.)*

Participants competing in **individual** or **family** events must wear attire appropriate to the requirements of their respective events. No special arrangements will be made. *(All participants are required to prepare their own competition attire.)*

Equipment Requirements

All participants must prepare and bring their own competition weapons and equipment.

Fair Play

To ensure the fairness of the competition, all forms of cheating are strictly prohibited. Any athlete found cheating will have **all competition results and awards revoked**, and his or her competition eligibility will be cancelled.
